OUTFIELD

Many games over the season are decided by a poor outfield play; a bad read on a ball, a bad throw or a missed cut-off man. The reason is that outfield defense is the most under-taught aspect of amateur baseball. Many mistakes are compounded in the outfield as often extra bases are taken. It is the last line of defence on a baseball field. This clinic will cover fielding ground balls and fly balls while outlining important drills to cover with your athletes.
