After completing this clinic you will be considered *In-Training*. Submitting the "post-task" **Mentor Journal Evaluation** will give you *Development 1 - Trained* status. To receive *Development 1 -Certified* status you will need to complete the **Make Ethical Decisions** (MED) Online Evaluation.
