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IMPACT AWARD 2021 NOMINATION PACKAGE

The Coaching Association of Canada presents the Impact Award to an individual or organization in recognition of their creation of an innovative event or program that has benefited the sport and coaching community. In response to a dynamic sport environment (ex. the COVID-19 pandemic and resulting period of restricted sport, the Black Lives Matter movement, the increasing collaboration and efforts to improve safety in sport, etc), the recipient has demonstrated perseverance and a determination to uplift those around them. The recipient has also shown a dedication to supporting marginalized groups in sport throughout the creation and implementation of the event or program.

The CAC recognizes the variety of contributors to the success of the sport system in Canada. Therefore, the CAC welcomes nominations for initiatives in any area that contributes to the growth and development of coaching (ex. education, research, accessibility of sport, professional development).

Eligibility requirements:

To be eligible to receive the Impact Award, the nominee must meet the following requirements:

- Have implemented a new event, initiative, or program that benefits members of their sport community
- Have positively impacted coaching and/or coach development in Canada as a result of the event, initiative, or program
- Have shown commitment to the core principles of the NCCP Code of Ethics: Leadership and professionalism, health and safety, and respect and integrity
- Have demonstrated dedication to embracing the values of equity, diversity, and inclusion when creating and implementing the event, initiative, or program

Selection process:

The CAC Awards Committee will review all nominations put forward by the deadline.

If successful, both the nominator and recipient will be contacted by the CAC. If unsuccessful, only the nominator will be sent a letter of decision.

Diversity and inclusion:

The Coaching Association of Canada is committed to promoting the values of diversity and inclusion and recognizes the tremendous contribution that all coaches make to the sport system in Canada and to the success of athletes on and off the field of play. The CAC welcomes nominations that reflect the diverse makeup of individuals in Canada.



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Award presentation and benefits:

The award will be presented at the annual Awards Gala at the Petro-Canada™ Sport Leadership sportif Conference. The 2021 recipient will receive:

- A gift and personalized award from the CAC
- Free registration for the 2021 Petro-Canada Sport Leadership sportif Conference

Nomination package:

Please ensure that the nomination package is complete, as incomplete packages will not be considered. The nomination package must include:

- Completed nomination form
- Letter of support from a parent organization, partner organization, or other organization relevant to the nominated individual or organization
- Supporting documentation (maximum of five pages) to provide any additional clarity or information, as determined by the nominator
